DR CONGO

Th 6. The President of Rwanda has withdrawn from the Luanda peace-process and is demanding that the Congolese government negotiate with the rebels. President Tshisekedi has repeatedly said this is a red line for DRC. Pray for the various actors who have the power to influence peace in DRC.

Fr 7. Give thanks for Anne, CMSI's longest serving staff member, faithfully serving in our finance department for almost 40 years. She is also celebrating a significant birthday today and would value prayer for ongoing stamina, strength and good health for herself and family members.

Sa 8. Give thanks for Paul and Alison Guinness' continued ministry in Burundi as they seek to encourage church leaders, providing tools to individuals who are sensing God's call to ministry and mission within their own context and outside the country.

PROVINCE OF ALEXANDRIA

We 12. Pray for Archbishop Samy Shehata as he presides over the dioceses of North Africa, the Horn of Africa, Gambella and Egypt.

Th 13. The Diocese of Egypt has developed many cultural bridging centres and the Centre for Christian Muslim Understanding. Pray for this important work towards cross cultural understanding.

Fr 14. Thank God for the growing fellowship of Sudanese Christians welcomed by the Diocese of Egypt. Pray for those who have been traumatised by the war and their journey from Sudan, and that the church may be a beacon of hope for them.

Sa 15. The church supports Sudanese refugees through schooling at St. Raphael School and children with learning disabilities through schooling at the Beacon Centre. Remember the children and teachers today and pray for life abundant for them.

Tu 1. Throughout the whole of Kibungo Diocese, only 12 out of 212 churches are open due to the strict Government clampdown on building regulations. Pray for the church pastors, lay leaders (catechists) and evangelists: the closure of the churches means they have no salaries.

GENERAL PRAYERS

Events

We 2. As our monthly online prayer room meets again today, thank God for opportunities like this that enable people to connect across vast distances. What a wonderful opportunity to support one another and learn together when we are physically apart!

DR CONGO

North Kivu Diocese

Th 3. Pray over Bishop Isesomo's concerns: "Some of our parishes are now in areas controlled by rebels. We are receiving many displaced people who fear those who massacre innocent civilians. Local church members host them in their homes. But the problem is getting food and medicines."

Fr 4. There are now almost 80 children at the children's project in Butembo. The children are often unwell for various reasons. We are thankful for parish support for their welfare needs. Pray for the health and wellbeing of everyone in this project.

CMSI FAMILY Staff

Sa 5. Pray for Gillian as she heads up the personnel department of CMSI and for her work with our Personnel Advisory Committee as they update various organisational policies and procedures over the coming months.

GENERAL PRAYERS

Su 6 "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ". Galatians 6:2 Ask God for strength and endurance as we help shoulder the weight of one another's lives.

Th 15. Pray for Bishop Martin as he leads the church in Goma in a time of political uncertainty. The training of clergy has encouraged him in recent months: "We are seeing real transformation in our students with a greater sense of call, godly character and competence in theology and ministry."
