BURUNDI

Mo 17. Please pray for President Évariste Ndayishimiye and his government. Pray for peace as the country prepares for the 2025 Elections and for the economy, which is at an all-time low, with steeply rising prices of most essential items such as food, fuel and building materials.

Gitega Diocese

Tu 18. After the Bishop's tour of all the parishes for confirmation services, he reports that the entire diocese is involved in church construction projects. Thank God for the hard work of parishes to achieve this and for the diocese as it seeks to help provide iron roofing sheets.

We 19. This period is a seed growing season in Burundi. Rain plays an important role in a country where the vast majority of households depend on agriculture for their livelihood. Pray for sufficient rain to ensure a good harvest.

Matana Diocese

Th 20. Pray for the pastors and people at two new church plants: Pastor Joseph Mihigo in Gisagara parish who has great gifts in preaching, and scores of people have been drawn to faith; Archdeacon Cassien Bukuru in Kiremba parish; and the newbuild at St Peter's Cathedral.

Fr 21. Praise God for the many new believers who have recently been baptised and confirmed, praying that they may grow in faith and discipleship. Pray for Bishop Seth Ndayirukiye, Revd Yvette Ndimahoro and Canon Etienne Manirakiza as they lead the diocese.



SOUTH SUDAN

Olo Diocese

Sa 22. Bishop Tandema and his diocese give thanks to God for the new clinic which has been completed after a wildfire destroyed the previous one. Give thanks with them!

Su 23. Pray for clergy who are in much need of theological training. Bishop Tandema hopes to be able to facilitate some teaching programmes for them this year.

PROVINCE OF ALEXANDRIA

Mo 24. Pray for each of the dioceses within the Province: North Africa, Horn of Africa, Egypt and Gambella.

Tu 25. Pray for Madame Madelaine as she heads up the Education Office of the church, and especially for St. Raphael School for Sudanese refugee children in Cairo.



We 26. Both the church hospitals are required to upgrade to new government standards. Pray for the vast resources needed and for the hospital managers who will lead this vital work.

SOUTH SUDAN

Ezo Diocese

Th 27. Diocesan infrastructure is limited in Ezo. School buildings, clergy accommodation and church buildings are all priorities this year.

Fr 28. Pray for the teams who spend time in outreach to camps for displaced people. Pray for their safety, for resources and for God to use them to transform lives.
